Looking for a preservation minded individual who loves the neighborhood and the architectural significance of the homes within the Historic Highlands Landmark District. Ideally someone with an architectural background and a passion for historic preservation. This position reports to the City of Pasadena Historic Preservation Commission as a 'Landmark District Representative'. The Landmark District Representative is responsible for input on landmark/architectural compliance for structures within the Historic Highlands Landmark District.

The position also fills the HHNA Historic Preservation Board position.

HHNA Will Help Facilitate Replacement of Home Tour Signs

Historic Highlands Neighborhood Association has hosted 16 Home Tours over the last 23 years, opening up 85 historical homes to the public for viewing. Each home originally had a plaque mounted in the yard signifying the historic significance. Over the years, some of these signs have been damaged, or removed by the owners. We inventoried the neighborhood 2 years ago and found 42 of the homes, previously on the Home Tour, had missing or damaged signs. Adriana Tiner is helping to coordinate with home owners who may want to upgrade or replace missing/damaged signs. If interested contact Adriana through Nextdoor Neighbors. North Lake Specific Plan

The North Lake Specific Plan, amended in 2007, provides neighborhood-specific design and land use regulations for an approximately 107-acre area in northern Pasadena. This Specific Plan area is generally bounded by Elizabeth Street to the north, Catalina Avenue, Mentor Avenue, and Wilson Avenue to the east, Maple Street to the south and El Molino Avenue and Hudson Avenue to the west. The Metro Gold Line Lake Station is located just outside the Specific Plan boundaries to the south. Other notable assets in the Specific Plan area include Washington Park and the historic Washington Theater.


